VIETNAMESE MASS: There will be a Vietnamese Mass on Sunday, November 15, 2015 at 2 p.m. All are welcome!

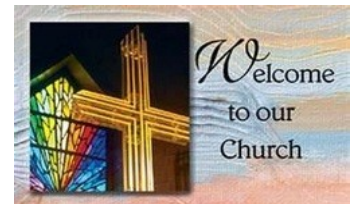
